

How to: Become a Friend of the Caravan

Step 1: When you click our 'Become a Friend' button, you will transfer into the Local Giving site & the screen opposite will come up.

If you'd like to become a regular donor Friend making a small monthly donation each month, please click the 'monthly donation' and enter the amount you wish to donate each month (say £3 a month).

If you want to become a Lifetime Friend (guidance £480 for a couple) or Ten-Year Friend (guidance £300 for a couple).

click the 'one off donation' and enter the sum you wish to donate.

Important note - at the bottom of the screen you will find a sliding scale in which Local Giving ask for a fee to finance their operation. If you do not want to pay this, click the "or enter a custom amount" line and enter £0.

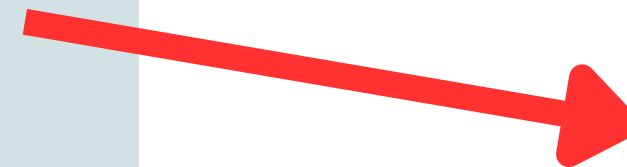


